

Between 29 February and 8 March 2016 The Australia Institute conducted a national opinion poll of 1412 people, through Research Now, with nationally representative samples by gender, age and state or territory.

The poll asked:

Q. The government has introduced legislation for a specific anti-corruption body for the building industry. Others have suggested a wider national Independent Commission Against Corruption. Which do you prefer?
