

Polling - Trust and Federal ICAC

May 2017

Key Results

The Australia Institute surveyed 1420 Australians about trust in Parliamentarians and a National Independent Commission Against Corruption.

- 63% of people have a low level of trust in federal parliament, and only 10% have a high level of trust
 - Trust is low both among LNP voters (51%) and Labor voters (61%)
 - Trust is lowest among non-major party voters (PHON 83%, Greens 73%, Other 67%, Undec 59%)
- 58% of people do not think current arrangements to investigate and expose misconduct and corruption in federal politics are effective
- 80% of people support establishing a federal ICAC
 - Support is highest among LNP voters (84%)
- 63% of people think a federal ICAC would increase their trust in federal parliament
 - Both LNP voters (68%) and Labor voters (61%) think that a federal ICAC would increase trust
- 78% of people support having a federal ICAC with public hearings
 - Support is high both among LNP voters (75%) and Labor voters (76%)
- More people think NSW ICAC has done a good job of investigating and exposing corruption than a poor job (37% good job, 22% poor job, with 41% don't know)

Method

From 17 March to 24 March 2017, The Australia Institute conducted a national poll of 1420 people through Research Now using representative samples by gender, age and state or territory. Results are presented in detail below with crosstabs by gender, larger states and voting intention in the House of Representatives.

Undecided voters were asked which way they were 'leaning', and these leanings are included in the party voting intention crosstabs. Results for undecided voters are also shown separately as 'Undec'. 'LNP' combines separate responses for Liberals and Nationals. 'Other' combines responses for Independent / Other and for the Nick Xenophon Team.
