

FINAL RESULTS

ReachTEL conducted a survey of 1,077 residents across **South Australia**, 656 residents across **Indi** and 662 residents across **New England** during the evening of 10th March 2016.

Question: *Of the following, how would you like to see asylum seekers and refugees who arrive in Australia by boat managed?*
