

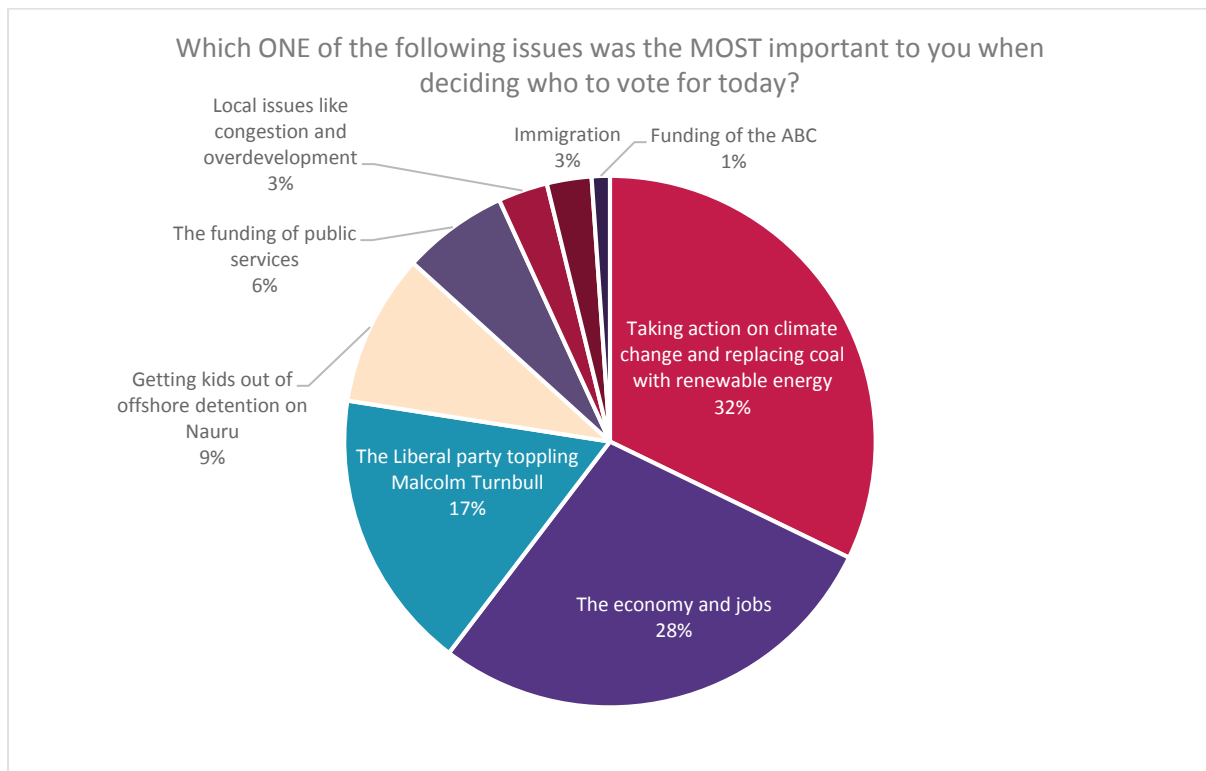
## Briefing note

21 October 2018

### Methodology

Figures included in this briefing note are results of an exit-poll of 985 respondents, commissioned by The Australia Institute, conducted by LonerGAN Research in the division of Wentworth on Saturday 20th October 2018. These results were collected face to face, as voters leave the booth on Election Day.

Polling was conducted at twelve separate polling places distributed evenly across Wentworth throughout the day. The booths were picked to give a good representation of the diversity of the electorate. Interviewing was conducted from 8AM-6PM, using CAPI - an interviewer administered methodology where results are collected directly onto a tablet for immediate processing. Results were weighted to booth, age and 2016 Federal Election vote.
