


Polling - SA Ministerial Name Recognition

February 2022


Key results

The Australia Institute surveyed a representative sample of 602 South Australians, asking them which State Government Ministers and shadow (Opposition) Ministers they had heard of.

Figure 1: Which current State Government Ministers have you heard of?







Method

The Australia Institute surveyed 602 adults living in South Australia between the 1st and 14th of February 2022, online through Dynata's panel, with representative samples by gender and age.

The results were weighted by two variables (gender x age group) based on the latest Australian Bureau of Statistics data, using the raking method. This resulted in an effective sample size of 535.

The margin of error (95% confidence level) for the results is 4%.

Voting intention questions appeared just after the initial demographic questions, before policy questions. Lower house voting intention was asked first, followed by upper house voting intention.

Respondents who answered "Don't know / Not sure" for voting intention questions were then asked a leaning question.

Voting crosstabs show voting intentions for the House of Assembly. Those who were undecided were asked which way they were leaning; these leanings are included in voting intention crosstabs. "Other" refers to Independent/Other.

Detailed results

No preceding questions in the poll are expected to have influenced the results of the questions on Ministerial name recognition.
