

uComms conducted a survey of 836 residents in the federal seat of Higgins on behalf of The Australia Institute during the evening of 2 May 2022 using self-completed automated voice polling methodologies (attached). The poll has a margin of error of 3.38%. The poll is Australian Polling Council compliant, with all questions and methodology publicly available.

Based on the results of this poll, the Australia Institute has calculated the below primary vote percentages for the respective parties, including the leanings of undecided voters as indicated in their poll answers.
