Method

The Australia Institute surveyed 616 adults living in South Australia between the 11th and 20th of September 2022, online through Dynata’s panel, with representative samples by gender and age.

The research is compliant with the [Australian Polling Council Quality Mark standards](#). The long methodology disclosure statement follows.

Long disclosure statement

The results were weighted by two variables (gender and age group) based on Australian Bureau of Statistics [“National, state and territory population”](#) data, using the raking method. This resulted in an effective sample size of 596.

The margin of error (95% confidence level) for the results is 4%.

Voting intention questions appeared after the initial demographic questions and before policy questions. Lower house voting intention was asked first, followed by upper house voting intention.

Respondents who answered “Don’t know / Not sure” for voting intention questions were then asked a leaning question. These leanings are included in the voting intention, gender and age crosstabs. “Other” refers to Independent/Other, and minor parties in cases where they were included in the voting intention but represent too small a sample to be reported separately in the crosstabs

The 2PP result was calculated using the overall preference flow from non-major parties at the 2022 state election.
