

Bass Strait Region proposed area




Bass Strait Region size: ~10,000 km² Avoids:

- Migratory bird flyways, breeding areas
- Key shipping lanes
- Minimum 20km from coastline

Minister can choose to:

- Declare the entire area as suitable
- Declare parts of the area as suitable
 - Declare an area (or part of an area) subject to conditions (that make it suitable)
 - Not declare the area

- Minimum 60 day period; October 24 January 31 (99 days)
