- *All figures have been weighted to be representative of Australian voters (the target population).*
- *Under gender those who selected the option of “Other” (0.73% of the total sample) have been randomly allocated to allow for weighting.*
- *All results are based on percentages and have been rounded to one decimal place*
- *When a question has only been asked to a select group of respondents this has been noted within the question title*
- *For the banner “2025 federal vote” all party names have been abbreviated as follows:*
 - *ALP – Labor*
 - *COA – Liberal / National Coalition*
 - *GRE – Greens*
 - *ON – Pauline Hanson’s One Nation*
 - *TOP – Trumpet of Patriots*
 - *IND – Independent*
 - *Other – Other parties*

Methodology:

YouGov conducted a national survey of 1,500 voters on behalf of The Australia Institute between 24 and 29 April 2025, using an online survey polling methodology. Full details are provided in the methodology statement. The poll is compliant with the Australian Polling Council’s requirements. The margin of error on the effective sample size is 3.27%.
