



Polling - Music and climate action in Australia

March 2025


Key results

The Australia Institute surveyed a nationally representative sample of 1,002 Australians about their attitudes towards their favourite music artists' potential involvement in various forms of climate action. The Australia Institute coordinated this survey with Planet Reimagined, which led a similar study of music concert ticket-buyers in the United States.

The results show that very few Australians have participated in any kind of climate action in the past 12 months – less than 20% in most cases, and less than 10% in others. However, the results also show that Australians are more likely to engage in range of climate-related actions if prompted by their favourite Australian music artist. For example:

- Almost one in three Australians (29%) are more likely to contact politicians or government officials about climate change if their favourite Australian music artist asked them to do so, compared to only 5% who have done so in the past 12 months.
- Around seven in ten Australians (69%) are more likely to discuss climate change with friends, family and others if their favourite Australian music artist asks them to do so, compared to one in two (50%) who have done so in the past 12 months.
- Only 4% of Australians have participated in a protest or public demonstration around climate change in the past 12 months. But one in four (25%) say they would participate in a protest or public demonstration about climate change if their favourite Australian music artist asks them to.
- While just one in six Australians (17%) have signed a petition about climate change in the past 12 months, more than half (54%) would do so if invited to by their favourite Australian music artist.


Figure 1: Likelihood of taking action on climate change, if prompted by artist



Respondents were asked how many concerts (live music events) they have been to in the past 12 months. They were also asked to choose from a list of various forms of climate action that they have engaged in over the past 12 months.

Music fans (people who go to concerts four or more times a year) are more likely to have participated in some form of climate action than those who attend concerts less often (one to three times per year).


Figure 2: Climate-related action in past 12 months, by rate of music event attendance



Respondents were asked how much they agree with Australian music artists speaking in public about their support for the following social issues: national security, inequality, health, education, the economy, the environment, climate change, integrity and corruption, Indigenous disadvantage.

- The majority of Australians support Australian music artists to speak out in public about their support for all of the above social issues.
- Australians are most likely to support Australian music artists who publicly speak out about the environment (72%), health (71%), and climate change (69%).


Figure 3: Support for Australian music artists' to speak out about social issues



Respondents were asked if they would see their favourite Australian music artist as more or less authentic, inspiring, likeable and credible if they included climate messages at their concerts.

- Most Australians would see their favourite Australian music artist as more authentic (55%), more inspiring (55%), more likeable (52%) and more credible (51%) if they include climate change messages at their concerts.


Figure 4: Perception of artists who include climate change messages at their concerts



Respondents were asked how much they would support their favourite Australian music artist in taking various forms of climate action. In all cases, most Australians support the action. For example:

- More than three in four Australians (77%) would support their favourite Australian music artist if they reduce emissions and waste at their concerts; only 14% oppose.
- More than two in three Australians would support their favourite Australian music artist if they host a special live event (67%) or share climate-related content on social media (66%).
- More than half of Australians (56%) would support their favourite music artist if they invite environmental organisations to engage with their fans at their concerts.

Figure 5: Support for artists who take various forms of climate action




Respondents were asked how important the issue of climate change is to them personally.

Overall, Australians think climate change is an important issue.

- 81% of Australians say climate change is personally important to them, of which 54% say it is either extremely important (23%) or very important (31%).
- Only 19% of Australians say that climate change is not personally important to them, of which 11% say it is not too important, and 8% say it is not at all important.
