

FINAL RESULTS

When interpreting this document, please consider the following items:

- For small sample (n<50) – interpret with caution
- All figures have been weighted to be representative of Australian eligible to vote
- The figures are based on a combination of quotas and weights and representative of all Australian eligible to vote by age, gender, region, education, household income and past vote.
 - Except for questions A Test and B Test have been weighted to Age gender region and education
- Non-binary gender weighting is equal to it's composition within the sample (n=11)
- All results are based on percentages and have been rounded to 0 decimal places
- Each question will contain banners for:
 - Total level results
 - Gender
 - Age Group
 - State
 - Future voting intention
- For the banner “Future voting intention” all party names have been abbreviated as follows:
 - ALP – Labor
 - COA – Liberal / National Coalition
 - GRE – Greens
 - ON – Pauline Hanson’s One Nation
 - IND – Independent
 - Other – Other parties
 - UND – Undecided

Methodology:

YouGov conducted a survey of 1541 Australian voters on behalf of The Australia Institute between from 2nd Oct to 9th Oct 2025, using an online polling methodology. Full details are provided in the methodology statement (<https://australiainstitute.org.au/australian-polling-council-long-methodology-disclosure-statements/>). The poll is compliant with the Australian Polling Council’s requirements.
